Those who voted for the winning charity were also entered into a drawing to win \$1,000 for themselves.

FamilyWize now offers <u>Medicine Cabinet</u>, a new feature that allows users to create a personal profile and gives them the ability to manage their prescriptions. Additionally, with the <u>FamilyWize Drug Price Lookup Tool</u>, consumers can quickly identify local pharmacies that provide the lowest price for their medications.
